Re: Tuition for Catholic, Non-Parishioner

I am delighted that you may be considering Queen of Heaven School for your child. As Pastor of Queen of Heaven Parish, I am very proud of our school, along with our Principal, Staff and Students.

The parish pays the difference between tuition and cost for all of our parishioners.

For parishes that do not have schools and have students attending Queen of Heaven School, these parishes are obligated to pay the difference between cost and the tuition.

It would be unjust for Queen of Heaven Parish to accept registrations from people living in other parishes, because then we would be assuming their responsibility and cost for a Catholic Education.

If you are registered at a parish without a school, please check with your pastor to make the necessary arrangements.

If you belong to a parish that already has a school, please check with your pastor. Normally, if a parish has a school, they do not subsidize parishioners going to other Catholic Schools. In other words, you will be most likely to pay the full cost.

This may sound confusing to some people, but basically each parish is responsible for the parishioners within its boundaries. We cannot assume responsibility for everyone.

If you have questions, be sure to check with your pastor.
