

Dear Incoming 5th Graders,



Your completed packet will be collected for a grade on the first day of school when we will begin our Roald Dahl author study.



Sophie takes one bite of the snozzcumber, spits it out and says it tastes of frog skins and rotten fish. What do snozzcumbers taste like to the BFG?




The palace contains hundreds of bedrooms. How is the BFG able to tell which bedroom belongs to the Queen? Where has Sophie seen the Queen before?




