

**QUEEN OF HEAVEN PRESCHOOL
REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION
2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR**

Queen of Heaven School's Pre-K4 program is in attendance five days a week from 8:15am-2:15 pm. This is a Catholic preschool program, but children do not have to be Catholic to attend. We follow the Diocesan approved curriculum for preschool, as well as the guidelines set forth by the Common Core Learning Standards for preschool. All children entering the Pre-K4 program must be completely "bathroom trained" and be four-years-old by December 1.

The preschool curriculum includes reading and math readiness, religion, art, music, science, physical education, computer technology, STEM, and Spanish. The overall goal of the program is to build a foundation for lifelong learning and to establish Kindergarten readiness. Each child is encouraged to gain independence while adjusting to a regular school routine. The children interact with other grade levels and participate in school masses, concerts and activities.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION PROCESS

- Registration Paperwork filled out completely
- Registration fee
- Family commitment form completed
- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Record

Registration applications are considered incomplete until the above paperwork is submitted.

All parents must have a tour AND meeting with the Principal.

Priority admittance is dependent on:

Siblings of current students in the building

Students repeating the program

Parishioners of Queen of Heaven or of a parish without a school

All other applicants

A maximum of 36 students are admitted to the preschool program each year. Both classrooms have a full-time certified teacher and aide. Waiting Lists occur each year, so registering early is a plus!
